Dear Parents and Student Athletes:

Adams 12 Five Star Schools does not provide transportation for student athletes to all athletic events. What this means to our athletes and parents is that you will assume more responsibility for getting yourselves or your student athletes to and from some events.

The bulleted items below are the travel procedures for the 2012-2013 school year:

- Transportation will not be provided for competitions or events within 10 driving miles of your home school.
- No transportation will be provided for athletic events held on Saturdays. Multi-day post season competitions may be exceptions to this procedure.

In cases where the travel is more than 10 miles, transportation will be provided to and from the contest (weekdays only). Athletes and families will have to provide their own transportation to and from contests on Saturdays.

Competitions that will occur within our school district boundaries will not have transportation. The furthest distance between schools during in-district competition is Legacy High School to Thornton High School at 9.6 miles. In cases when a particular sport requires that student athletes are suited up at their home school location and they are wearing equipment that could interfere with driving safety, exceptions will be made to the procedure and transportation will be provided.

Coaches will share the bus schedules and athletic schedules with you. The athletic secretary at your school will have copies of both the transportation schedules and the athletic schedules in the office.
