School physicals are NOT included in incoming records for any students entering Legacy. You must obtain a copy of your valid physical form from your previous school to bring with you to the Legacy athletic check-in. As a reminder, physicals are valid for one calendar year only.

STUDENT & FAMILY ACTIVITY CARDS

The admission price for all sporting events for the school year 2014-2015 is as follows:

Adults - \$5; Students (K through 12) - \$4; under 5 - free.

Complimentary activity cards for senior citizens are available for people 62 years of age or older. For more information, call the District Athletic Office at 720-972-5922. Activity cards are available to purchase for use at all HOME sporting events (excluding district, regional, or state play-off games). They may not be used at away games.

The cost is \$30 for the student card (unlimited admissions) to home sporting events. Family cards are available for \$70 each; each card contains 24 punches. One punch per family member obtains admittance to any home sporting event. Purchase cards from the bookkeeper.

COMPETITIONS

No signs or banners can be held up or posted at competitions. Students must keep their shirts on at all times. The Front Range League and CHSAA have a policy that prohibits noise makers at any competition. Examples include but are not limited to thundersticks, cowbells, horns or whistles. Please model positive fan behavior, and remember to cheer for our team, not against our opponent. Thank you for your cooperation.
