Course Selection

- **Check to see that you have taken and passed the prerequisite course** (Check Full-Length Registration Guide) ex. Culinary Essentials I before Culinary Essentials II
- **Certain class placements are determined by administration.** Examples include ELL, Discrete Math, Business Math, Special Offerings, CP vs. non-CP Sciences
- **AP courses require an AP contract, due Feb. 8**
 - Must attend after school AP information sessions



State SAT- April 9th



All students will automatically be registered to take the SAT; however, students may also opt to take the SAT with Essay on April 9th.

If you are interested in taking the SAT with Essay, you must register online using your College Board account between January 16th and February 14th. If you do not register during this window, you will be unable to register at a later date. Also, you will not be able to remove your registration for the SAT with Essay if you change your mind after the window closes.

Please note that students taking the SAT with Essay will be responsible for their own transportation home on April 10th.

State SAT

- Should You Take the SAT Essay? Five Scenarios to Help You Decide:
 - Scenario 1: You're planning on applying to at least one school that requires the essay
 - Scenario 2: None of the schools you're applying to look at essay scores
 - Scenario 3: The schools you're applying to don't require the SAT essay and aren't highly competitive
 - Scenario 4: The schools you're applying to recommend the SAT essay and are more competitive
 - Scenario 5: You aren't sure where you're going to apply yet
