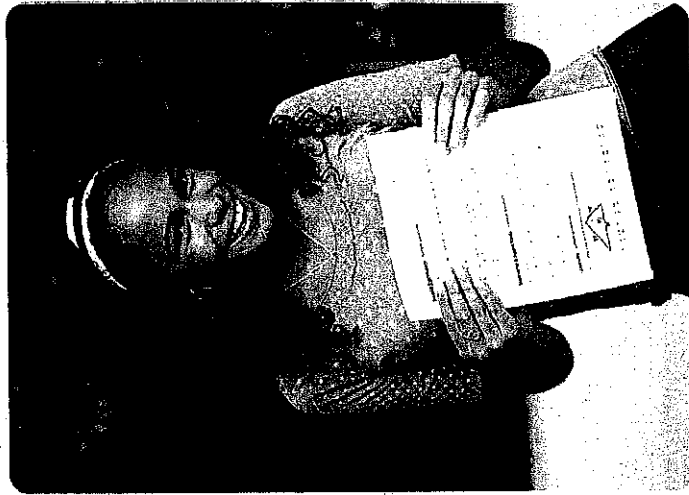

Call 720-887-2360 to reserve your spot or just drop in between the hours of 5-7 p.m. on Tuesday evenings.

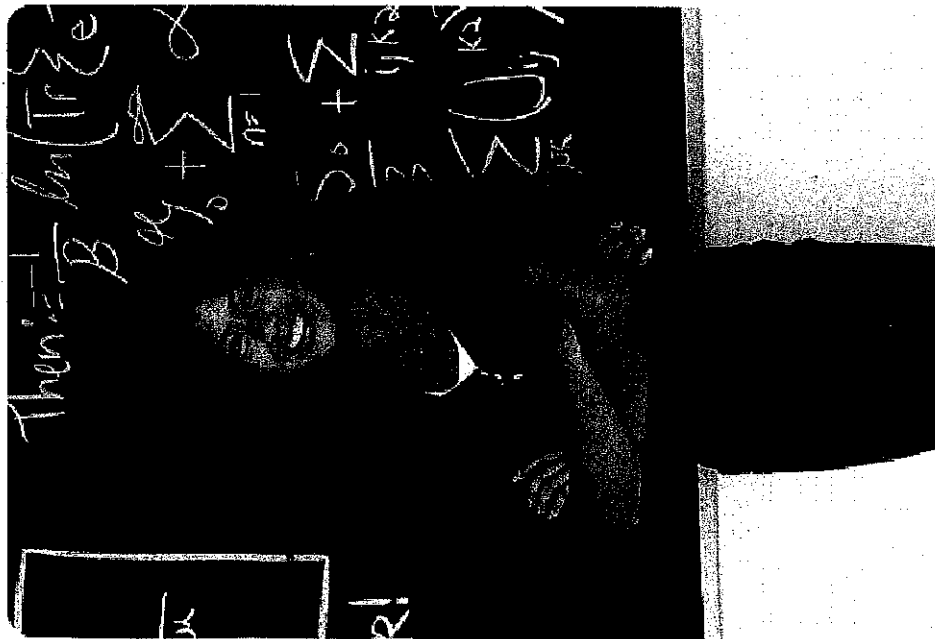
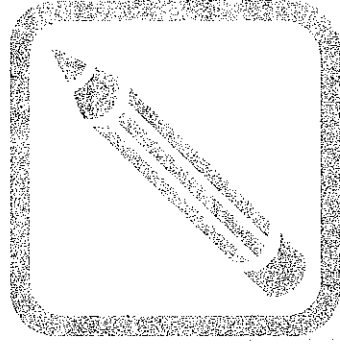
Adult volunteers will be available to tutor students for half-hour sessions!

# Math Troubles?

## Don't Give Up! Get Help!

1. Do every homework assignment. Make the attempt. If you mess up, your teacher can look at your work and see what you don't understand.
2. Ask questions in class. Make it a goal not to leave class without understanding what you need to do.
3. Attend Academic Support!
4. Go to Peer Tutoring.
5. If you do poorly on a test, make use of the second opportunity.
6. Get free tutoring, at the Broomfield Public Library on Tuesdays from 5-7 pm. Sign in at the Teen Zone Desk on the second floor of the library. Call 720-887-2360 to reserve a half hour spot or just drop in.
