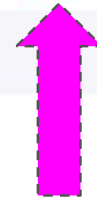
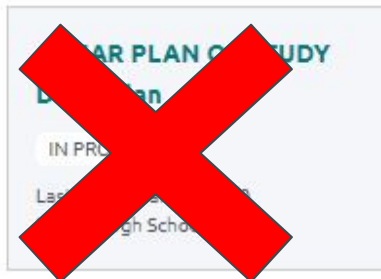


Manage Course Plans

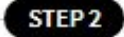

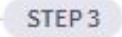
