

Introduction


You are about to begin the Career Interest Profiler, a tool that can help you discover the types of work activities and career interests that people do at their jobs.

Enterprising occupations frequently involve starting up and carrying out projects. These occupations can involve leading people and making many decisions. Sometimes they require risk taking and often deal with business.


Conventional 9

Many of the occupations require working outside, and do not involve a lot of paperwork or working closely with others.
